Schwulenberatung Berlin offers counseling and support for those affected by discrimination. It is our mission to undermine those who discriminate against the LGBT community and to support the victims - regardless if they are trans*, migrant, living with HIV/AIDS, or an ethnic minority. Anyone who has experienced discrimination because of their sexual or gender identity is welcomed.

What does StandUp offer?

- Counseling and support services in incidents of discrimination
 - For example: police mistreatment, conflict resolution, law and civil rights information
- Lessons on how to act when confronted with discrimination
- Support in multiple languages - not just German
- Workshops, lectures, and training for other LGBT projects and NGOs
- Counseling and orientation for situations like a Transwomen in entering a Women-only-area (for example)
- Network of other LGBT organizations that can help in the area
